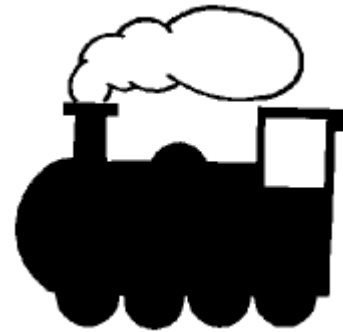


The Team

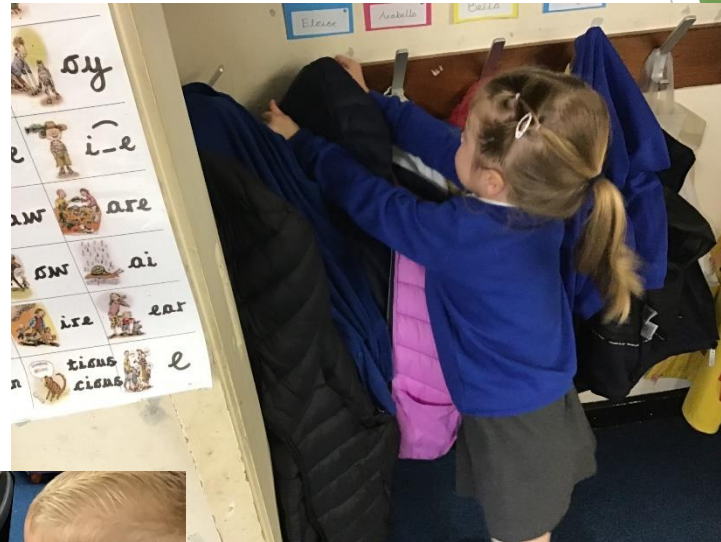
