Think of an interesting way to design your poem -or- Learn and recite the poem 'The Owl and The Pussycat'.</p> 	<p><u>DT/Cooking</u></p>  <p>Design and make some cookies for Little Red Riding Hood or make a gingerbread man to star in your own story.</p> <p>Write out the recipe with step-by-step instructions and pictures for each step.</p>	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>Create a forest scene. Choose from different media e.g. paint, pen, pencil, collage materials.</p> 
<p><u>E4S and Computing</u></p> <p>Create a poster to inform other children how to stay safe online.</p> 	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>What materials would make a good house for the Three Little Pigs? Use a range of materials to make different houses and test out which material is the strongest. Use a hairdryer to test each house out. Record your results.</p> 	<p><u>Map making</u></p> <p>Draw a map of an imaginary land. Label the features on your map. Which are physical features and which are human features?</p> <p>Write a set of instructions to find your way from one part of your land to another using North, East South and West.</p> 	<p><u>Historical enquiry</u></p> <p>Find out about the Great Fire of London.</p> <p>Choose how to present your information e.g. a poster, fact file, Power Point presentation.</p>
