

Extended Parent Consultations

- These meetings are for all pupils with SEND.
- This meeting is instead of a Parent Consultation.
- The Extended Parent Consultation meeting time is 20 minutes instead of 10 minutes. This allows time for discussions around progress towards Individual Learning Plan (ILP) targets.
- The class teacher, intervention teacher for your child's year group and SENDCo will be present for this meeting in the autumn term.

Extended Parent Consultations

This term we are making some changes to Extended Parent Consultations.

- To make these meetings as effective as possible Extended Parent Consultations are going to take place a few weeks later than usual. This will enable:
 - pupils to have a greater understanding of the progress they are making across the term
 - the maximum amount of time to be spent working on ILP targets
 - our Assess, Plan, Do, Review cycle to be strengthened
 - the reviewing and setting of targets to be smooth and uninterrupted
- During this meeting the current term's targets will be reviewed and the next term's targets set. This will enable a smooth transition between terms, as well as to maximize the amount of time spent working on targets.
